Dear Friend,

Nearly 40 years ago, I visited Egypt while on tour with the U.S. Department of State; little did I know this trip would be why Coptic Orphans would come to fruition. I encountered Coptic Children living in orphanages because their fathers, the primary breadwinners, had died, and their mothers had no means to feed or clothe them. After the trip, I recruited a few friends to join me in pooling funds to send to the orphanage each month, ensuring the 45 girls who lived there had their basic necessities taken care of.

This year, we are celebrating our 35th anniversary of fighting against the vicious cycle of poverty that our brothers and sisters in Egypt have endured. This year's theme is "From Generation to Generation", where we celebrate the accomplishments of the organization thanks to donors like you while shaping the future for our Coptic community.
